Parents are to understand that the education process is not complete until their students have developed a solid biblical worldview and a healthy fear of God (Romans 12:1–2, Philippians 2:5, 2 Corinthians 10:5, Ecclesiastes 12:13).

Parents are not to permit education to be a hindrance to their children's spiritual, moral, or social development (Matthew 18:6, 19:13–14, Mark 10:13–16, Luke 18:15–17).
