A Biblical Worldview of Love

- 1. Love **starts** with God.
 - a. He makes love possible.
 - b. He makes love personal.
- 2. Love is **extended** through believers.
 - a. Love is a sign of true faith.
 - b. Love **motivates** the believer to actively pursue a life of love.

Point: Love is the most tangible *expression* of God.

Deal with Your Blind Spots!

- 1. Blind Spots #1 **Justifying** yourself! (Luke 10:25-37)
- 2. Blind Spot #2: All **talk**, no **walk**! (1 John 3:18)
- 3. Blind Spot #3: Love at the expense of **truth**! (John 8:7-11)
