

### The Wheat and the Weeds!

June 23, 2024 – Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43 Pastor Jon Pickens

### The Parable of the Weeds

- 1. The Problem: The enemy of the wheat farmer seeks to **sabotage** the farmer's field.
- 2. Two Options:
  - a. Quick Response: Go and gather the weeds **right away**.
  - b. Patient Response: Wait until **harvest** time so that none of the wheat is uprooted.
- 3. The Conclusion: When <u>harvest</u> comes, the weeds will be bundled and burned and the wheat will be gathered in the sower's barn.

## The Meaning of the Parable

- 1. The big question this parable is addressing is about the **timing** of when the Son of Man will deal with evil in this world.
- Jesus will deal with evil at the <u>end</u> of the <u>age</u>.

# The Implications of Its Meaning

- 1. **Trust** that God's delay in dealing with evil comes from a place of love.
- 2. Don't become overly focused on trying to rid the world of evil.
- 3. Focus on being **fruitful** wheat!
  - a. Pursue holiness!
  - b. Be **patient**, but be a **part** of what God is doing!
  - c. Live **peace**-filled lives!
  - d. Care about souls!

- 3. Read 2 Peter 3:1-15. How do Peter's words parallel with this parable in Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43?

- 5. What action are you going to take as a result of what God's Word teaches?
