What Good News Will the Messiah Proclaim?

1.	He will proclaim a Gospel that teaches us that God's <u>riches</u> at Christ's <u>expense</u> is infinitely better than the riches of this world.
2.	He will proclaim a Gospel that sets people free from their bondage to sin and death.
3.	He will proclaim a Gospel that can open the eyes of the spiritually blind so that they can see the beauty of the Lord Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How are you, as a follower of Jesus, rich? How does this motivate you?
- 2. In what ways has Jesus set you free?
- 3. How would you describe Christian freedom and how can it abused?
- 4. In what ways can a Christian still be in bondage? What does it look like for Jesus to set them free?
- 5. We know that the Spirit opens our eyes to see the truth of the Gospel and then we believe. How has spiritual blindness showed itself over the course of your life? What did God use to open your eyes?
- 6. What action are you going to do as a result of the message?
