You Will Share the Gospel with Four Types of People

| 2. | You will share with those who are <u>receptive</u> but then <u>dismiss</u> the Gospel when their faith cos |

1. You will share with those who are **dismissive** of the Gospel because they just don't get it.

- 3. You will share with people who will hear the Gospel, but their love for what is **temporary** proves to be greater than their love for what is **eternal**.
- 4. You will share the Gospel with people who hear the Gospel, receive it, and bear fruit.

Three Principles about Sharing the Gospel

- 1. God is at work preparing hearts to receive the seed of the Gospel, so share it with **expectation**.
- 2. When we sow the seed of the Gospel, we don't know what kind of soil it will land in, so share it **abundantly**.
- 3. Our responsibility is to scatter the seed of the Gospel knowing God is the one who makes it fruitful, so share the Gospel **obediently**.

- 3. As you consider the parable of the sower and what it has to do with evangelism, how does it encourage you to share the Gospel more?

- 5. How are you going to share the Gospel abundantly?
- 6. What action are you going to do as a result of the message?
