Preparing for Effective Evangelism

1. You need to first and foremost prepare your **heart** for effective evangelism.

“Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts”

2. You also need to prepare your **mind** for effective evangelism.

“always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you”

3. Prepare your **posture** for effective evangelism.

“yet with gentleness and reverence”
