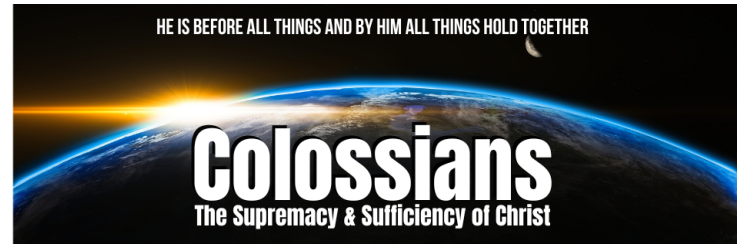


How to Live With Yourself
