2. Considering the sovereign reign of God, how can this encourage your heart as you consider what is happening in our world?
3. We do not see God with our physical eyes, but we can vision for the true God nonetheless. Can you remember a time when your vision of God seemed particularly clear? How did you respond?
4. What is so amazing about vs. 6-7 that can encourage your walk with Jesus?
5. What is a take-away for you from the message or this passage?
6. Whether you are alone or in a Life Group, spend some time praising and thanking God for his attributes. Name them, express to Him why they are meaningful to you, and thank Him for them.
