What Do the Witnesses of the Resurrection Tell Us?
1. The resurrection of Jesus is an undeniable <b>fact</b> .
a. Based on the <b>multitude</b> of witnesses.
b. Based on the <b>commitment</b> of those who claimed Jesus rose from the dead.
The resurrection of Jesus is absolutely <u>central</u> to the Gospel message.
<ul> <li>God left witnesses of the resurrection to <u>establish</u> it as critical to the Gospel message.</li> </ul>
b. The central message of the Gospel of hope depends on the resurrection.
i. Believers are <b>spiritually</b> raised with Christ.
ii. Believers will be <b>physically</b> raised from the dead.

### How does this resurrection hope change us?

1. This resurrection hope **motivates** us to live a life of **sacrifice**.

- 5. What are you holding onto that YOU need to surrender to Jesus?
