The Background of The Day of Atonement

1. It was picture of God's holiness.
2. It was a warning to repent.
3. It was a picture of both propitiation and judgment.
4. The year of Jubilee is a picture of restoration, rest, and joy.

Fulfillment of the Day of Atonement

1. Present: Jesus is both the final High Priest and sacrifice for sin.
2. Future: Jesus will return to both rescue His people and purge this world of sin.
