Big Idea: Spread the fame of His name to every nation. Give the glory to His name in every endeavor.

Discussion Questions:

1. Why do you think Canaan is singled out for divine judgment rather than Ham? Is this “fair”?
2. How should Christians view the nations and peoples of the world? How does Genesis 10-11 contribute to our understanding of the nations? (See Psalm 2 and Psalm 98 for further reflection).
3. Can salvation be passed down by bloodline, genetics, or ethnic identity? If not, then how *does* someone receive salvation according to the Bible?
4. What is God’s current plan for the nations? (See Acts 17:22-31, Matthew 28:18-20 for further reflection)
5. What is God’s future goal for the nations? (See Revelation 5:9-10)
6. We normally think of “unity” as a good thing for humanity. Why was the “unity” of the Babel builders a bad thing in God’s eyes?
7. How can we be involved in “building God’s kingdom”?
8. What is the legacy of the city of Babel? (See Revelation 18:1-10)
