Message 2: Making Christ-Centered Disciples

Text: Colossians 1:15-29

Big Idea: Jesus is the central pursuit and motivation of a disciple's worship, growth, and ministry.

Outline:

1. "Christ-First" is the Heart Cry of a Worshipping Disciple (Col. 1:15-20, Rev. 5:1-14)

2. "Christlike" is the Goal of a Mature Disciple (Col. 1:21-23, 28, 2:6, Eph. 4:13, 15-16)

3. "Christ-Proclaiming" is the Ministry of a Disciple-Making Disciple (Col. 1:24-29, 1 Cor. 1:4-2:5)

Discussion Questions:

1. What stands out to you from the description of Jesus in Colossians 1?
2. What does it mean for Jesus to be “preeminent” in everything? How can we make Jesus preeminent in our own lives?
3. What kinds of other things do we tend to put in the place of preeminence in our lives? What happens when Jesus is “out of place” in the heart of a disciple?
4. How is Jesus part of the ongoing work of transformation in the life of a disciple?
5. What is a Christlike quality that you have been growing in by God’s grace? What is a Christlike quality that you have seen a fellow disciple growing in by God’s grace?
6. How can we help fellow disciples in our church and homes be more Christlike?
7. What is the message Paul proclaims? How would you summarize and share this message in your own words?
8. How is every disciple “called to ministry”? In other words, how is an ordinary Christian called to be involved in making disciples?
