Message 4: Making Disciples in the Home

Text: Deuteronomy 6:1-9, 20-25, Acts 2:42-47, 5:42

Big Idea: A disciple follows Jesus hand-in-hand, home-to-home, and from son-to-son.

Outline:

1. Hand-in-hand - Discipleship is lived out in relational connection (John 13:34-35)

2. Home-to-home - Discipleship is lived out in the rhythms of daily life in the home (Acts 2:42-47, 5:40-42)

3. Son-to-Son - Discipleship is lived out and passed on in family relationships first (Deuteronomy 6:1-9)

Discussion Questions:

1. Why do relationships with other disciples matter as we follow Jesus?
2. Who is another disciple who has helped you follow Jesus? How did they disciple you?
3. What problems might the “lone ranger” disciple have?
4. What does Acts 2:42-47 teach us about the home and “breaking bread” in the lifestyle of early disciples?
5. Why might the home sometimes be the hardest place to be a disciple of Jesus?
6. How can you use your home and dinner table (or apartment, residence, etc.) as a discipleship tool?
7. How can the church incorporate and love those whose home looks different from a typical marriage and children arrangement (i.e. the single, divorced, widowed, and childless)?
8. What is one way a parent can disciple their children?
9. How can our church help support homes, marriages, and parents?
