Discussion Questions:

1. God is called "God Almighty" in Genesis 28:3. What difference does a vision of God as "almighty" make in your life today?
2. God's power (sometimes called "omnipotence") is one of the first things children can understand about God, but adults can easily forget it! Is there a simple truth about God that you need to be reminded about today?
3. God is still working to keep and fulfill His promises in Genesis 27-28. What is a promise from God's Word that He is still working to keep or fulfill today?
4. Why is Esau excluded from the blessing?
5. Is God's love in the Bible too exclusive (or narrow)? Why or why not?
