Brick #1 - Scripture

	a.	Scripture is God's <u>revelation</u> to us about Himself and His creation.

- b. The Scriptures are **inspired** by God and **profitable** to us.
- c. It is by the Scriptures that we are **sanctified**.
- 2. The Scriptures are necessary for spiritually **mature** relationships.
- 3. The Scriptures will guard the community from **deceit** and theological **instability**.
- 4. The Scriptures ultimately lead this supernatural community toward **love**.

What Does This Mean for Us?

- 1. It means that our aim at FBC is for you to **know** the Bible.
- 2. It means that our desire at FBC is for you to **think** Biblically.
- 3. It means that our prayer at FBC is that you would align your life around the Scriptures.
- 4. It means that genuine Biblical community **cannot** be **built** apart from the Bible.
