Brick #2 – Christ Is the Cornerstone of Genuine Community

1. Without Jesus genuine biblical community loses its orientation.
2. Without Jesus genuine biblical community loses its unity to weather the attacks of the enemy against the Church.
3. Without Jesus biblical community loses its identity.
