Discussion Questions

1. One of the main points of Genesis 2 is that humans are creatures hand-crafted by God. Which aspect of this (either our creatureliness or our being made by God) do you find relevant for your life this week?
2. Genesis teaches that men and women are both image bearers of God and yet they fulfill different roles that complement one another. But this passage doesn't provide much information about what those differences are specifically. What do you think they are? How should a wife be a "helper" to her husband?
3. God doesn't simply provide humanity's bare necessities. His creation abounds with his good provision. Do you view God as fundamentally good? What things threaten your belief in his character?
4. What seems to be the point of God commanding Adam not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil?
