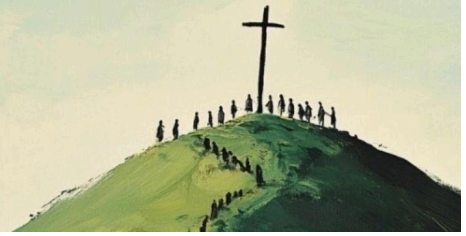


Sharing Together in God's Joy

Big Idea: God's sufficient supply room of strength and riches in Christ Jesus fills me up with contentment and flows over in giving.

Discussion Questions:

1. Can you think of another story from the Bible that showcases God as a “Supplier” or “Provider”?
2. Can you think of a time in your own life when God supplied strength to face difficult circumstances? ...or when God supplied a material need?
3. Critical thinking: Does God *always* meet our material needs?
4. What is the greatest and deepest need that mankind needs supplied?
5. How is the gospel of Jesus a story of God “providing” for us?
6. When do you think it’s harder to be content, in “hunger” or in “plenty”? Why?
7. How does Philippians 4:13 tend to be misunderstood and misapplied? In your own words, what does it actually mean?
8. Why should Christians give financially to support ministry partners?
9. What principles (from this passage or elsewhere in Scripture) should guide our financial giving?
