

Made for More Genesis 1:26-2:20

Big Idea: I am made for more than my own little kingdom. I am made to rule as God's representative over His creation by expansively establishing order for His glory and to find my fulfillment in Him.

 Made for Dominion – to Rule over Creation Under Him as His Representatives

2. Made for Work, Procreation, and Creation Care – the Details of Dominion

3. Made for Rest and Fulfillment – the Blessings that come with Dominion

Discussion Questions:

- 1. If God is the King over creation, why do you think He would allow mankind to rule over His world?
- 2. Collectively as a whole, do you think mankind has done a good job ruling over God's world? Why or why not?
- 3. How is the "image of God" related to the command to "have dominion"?
- 4. How can you personally and practically be involved in God's command to "have dominion" over the earth on a daily and individual basis?
- 5. How does this passage affect how you approach your "secular job"?
- 6. Does "having dominion" mean that mankind gets to use the earth and its resources however we want? Explain.
- 7. What should we do when our worship and "Sabbath" starts to feel like a burden rather than a blessing? (See Mark 2:23-28)
- 8. What are ways in which we tend to "live for our own little kingdom" rather than God's glory?
- 9. How would you apply this passage to someone...
 - Going through a "mid-life crisis" (or general "existential crisis")?
 - Who recently graduated high school and is seeking direction for their life?
 - Who hates their job and finds no fulfillment in it?
 - Whose "workaholic" mindset never seems to find time for God or family?
