

A Marriage Made by God

Genesis 2:15-25

Big Idea: God's design for the family starts with one man and one woman as equal image-bearers with complementary roles made one flesh by a good God.

- 1. God's Design for Marriage: One Man, One Woman, One Flesh, Given by God
 - 1) The Wonder of Marriage
 - 2) The Definition of Marriage
- God's Design for Gender Roles: Equal Image-Bearers Made for Complementary Roles of Headship and Helper
 - 1) Equal Image-Bearers
 - 2) Complementary Roles of Headship and Helper
 - 3) The Hope for Broken People: Gospel Grace

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What stands out to you most from what Genesis 1-2 establishes about gender, marriage, and the family? Is there anything *surprising*, *relevant*, or especially *practical* from this passage to you?
- 2. Are marriage and family in our culture in "crisis"? If so, what can Christians do about it?
- 3. How would you help apply some of the ideas of this passage to the following people?
 - A married Christian couple whose relationship has grown "stale" and "cold."
 - A single Christian woman longing for marriage.
 - A young man who is wrestling with his "gender identity" and sexuality.
 - A woman who has experienced the shame of divorce and the hurt of having an angry husband (similar to the woman of John 4).
- 4. How does the Christian understanding of gender, sexuality, and marriage differ from our culture's? How should Christians speak and interact with unbelievers on these topics?
- 5. How are men and women *the same* before God? How are men and women *different* according to God's design?
