Discussion Questions:

- 1. In the Christian worldview, is it better to be a man or a woman?
- 2. How are men and women *the same* before God? How are men and women *different* according to God's design?
- 3. Is God's plan for gender roles harmful to women? Why or why not?
- 4. Whether you are married or not, how does your identity as either male or female affect God's plan and purpose for you?
- 5. If you are married, how do the ideas of this message impact your own marriage relationship? Are there any patterns in your marriage that you need to either reinforce or rethink as a result of this message?
- 6. Does male headship mean that the husband "always get his way" in the home? If not, what does it mean practically for a marriage?
