Psalm 8

**Big Idea**: Meditate on creation's majesty and be motivated to live out God's big purpose for you.

## Outline:

1. Who is God? - Big! Majestic, Worthy of "Wow!"

2. Who am I? – Small, Frail, Returning to Dust

3. Who am I? – Given a Big Purpose, a Position of Privilege that Comes with a Mandate, Made for More than Mere Comfort.

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What's something in creation that makes you say, "wow!" What does it communicate about our Creator?
- 2. Would you say mankind's place in the universe is significant or insignificant?
- 3. Why do you think such a big God takes an interest in human beings?
- 4. How could you describe in your own words the position and purpose that God has given mankind? How can you live out this job responsibility in your everyday ordinary life?
- 5. How does Jesus add to what Genesis says we were made for?
- 6. What are some lesser goals that tend to take the place of what God made us for? (example: being comfortable).
- 7. Do you have any ambitions, goals, or resolutions for 2026? How do the ideas of this message help inform those goals?
