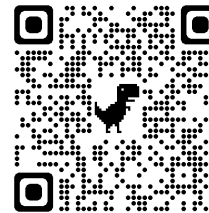

Into the Pit and out of the Pit by Power of Yahweh

"O Lord, this wasn't supposed to happen to me. Why Lord, why did you take my loved one?" Or have you ever wondered, "How do I help that person who is grieving their loss? What should I say? What should I do?" Well, this class is for you. It is designed for anyone who has lost a loved one recently or well in the past, and for those who would like to help someone who is grieving.
