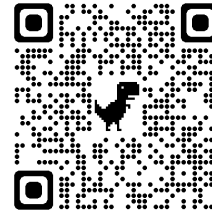

While things wrap up at Camp Nathanael on Thursday morning, we will head toward Cedar Point, where we will enjoy a day at America's Roller Coast. We will arrive back home late Friday evening. Those who are entering 9th grade in the fall up through those graduating from High School this May are eligible to join us for the trip. The cost will be \$260 plus 4 meals on the road.
